Smart City Rourkela

Government of India has announced the names of 98 urban centres and cities that have been nominated by the state governments for the "Smart City" scheme. Rourkela is a one of them.

Announcing the nominations, urban development minister M Venkaiah Naidu said it was a good signal that 65 small and medium towns and cities have made it to the list of smart city aspirants. The identified 98 urban areas, which fall under municipal jurisdictions, will cover about 13 crore people accounting for over 35% of the country's total urban population.

Adequate water supply, assured electricity supply, sanitation, including solid waste management, efficient urban mobility and public transport, affordable housing, especially for the poor, robust IT connectivity and digitalization, safety and security of citizens and health and education facilities involve the core infrastructure elements of the 'smart city' project.

Launching of MDD (Inauguration of Syasthya Ratha)

The MDD campaign at city level was inaugurated by respected ADM, Rourkela. At the outset in the presence of all officials invited for the Launching ceremony, ADM, Rourkela waved the green flag and inaugurated the Syasthya Ratha. The Ratha was moved for three days around the city with special focus to the slums. The main objective of the Ratha was to aware the people on Malaria, Dengue, Diarrhia (MDD). Also during the Ratha movement in different slums leaflets were distributed among the peoples regarding hand washing, preparation of ORS, use of ORS and Zinc, best personal and environmental health and hygiene practices, use of mosquito net etc.

Also the VBD consultant, NRHM, Sundergarh had a presentation on the prevention, Precaution, treatment of Malaria, Dengue and Diarrhea. After the detail sharing on different aspects finally the Health Officer, RMC, RKI extended the vote of thanks to the chair and the meeting was winded up.
