Civil Township Mini Stadium Play Ground



The open ground was made encroachment free and provided with boundary wall and mini gallery on the eastern part of the ground with an estimated cost of Rs.40 Lakhs. Earth leveling work was done to remove the undulated surface. The ground has been developed to a good play ground which is used by Children as well as youths for games, sports and athletics.

Self Employment Program under NULM

To upgrade the qualitative and quantitative life of urban poor financial assistance to individual or group of people for setting up gain full Self Employment venture applicable to their skill and local condition is essential. Under National Urban Livelihood Mission, Self Employment Program is a vital component for the economical growth of urban poor.



Sri Ajay Kumar Barik is an unemployed youth having BPL card residing in Nayabazar, Rourkela. His sister in law is a member of SHAMA SHG. The Self Employment Program was discussed in all women of the SHG .After collection of form the Task Force committee recommended to Union Bank of India for sanction of loan. Sri Barik availed the loan amounting Rs. 2,00,000/- to purchase an Auto and Drive. Now he is able to earn Rs.300/- daily on an average and repaid loan regularly.



Skill Training & Placement



The upgradation and development of the skill of urban poor is an essential component under NULM. To enhance their capacity of Self employment and salaried employment strategic measure was taken to ensure placement in future. The basic objective is to provide training to the urban poor for Employment through Training & Placement (EST&P). As per the need of beneficiaries and the want of the society training program is identified and scheduled in such a manner that optimum result is obtained with minimal efforts.

There are 119 nos. of boys & girls are now undergoing on training different trades like Computer, Beautician, and Driving etc. As per tripartite agreement 50% of the qualified trainees would be supplied with applicable jobs & rest will be engaged on self employment program.
