Early morning follow up is started at 03:30 AM on all wards till 06:00 AM, mostly at the place where open defecation is there.

BT Road at Basanti Colony



The project improvement and widening of road at Baji Road chowk to Over bridge at Basanit colony with an estimated cost of Rs.15.60 lakhs. The project is completed and open to use by the citizen.

Drain Construction at C2M Chhend

The Drain and Culvert work with an estimated cost of Rs. 13.52 lakhs is in progress.



Verification of Beneficiary Led Housing



Field verification of beneficiary is going on at vedvyas area under "Beneficiary Led Housing Scheme" (PMAY). 18 nos. of beneficiary have been verified at Pharsatola. The RMC team (Amin, Work Sarkar) have verified the entire houses infrastructure. During the verification 13 nos. of beneficiary are found eligible.

CC Road at Tunguritola

The park bounded with boundary wall, children play equipment, walking. The work is in progress with an estimated cost of Rs. 8.96 lakhs in Corporation of own fund. After completion, play equipments will be provided for benefit of all children.

The internal approach road to the connected with branch road to market and branch road to panposh vegetable market will provide all weather conveyance to the public and vendors & shopkeepers.

The Renovation work at Govt. College Road (BT) has been completed. The project was taken up with an estimated cost of Rs.35.00 lakhs out of 14th F.C grant 2015-16. This is a major connecting road from main road to Mahatab Road will facilitate good connectivity to the commuters, students and staffs of Govt. College as well as general public.



Animal Birth Control Programme for street dogs

ABC programme for street dogs is going on with co-operation of Veterinary Department. 20 nos. Kennels O.T setup to carry on the programme with target of 20 nos. of dogs per week was standard since 2013, Nodal Officer, ABC Programme, at Govt. Veterinary Hospital campus is monitoring the dog sterilization programme.

A monitoring committee consisting Municipal Commissioner as Chariman & Ex-Officio's CDVO, SDVO with SPCA member Mr. Kisun Sahoo, Nodal officer, RSP, Mr. Sangram Parida, Managing Trustee, ARMY monitoring the programme properly. Adequate dog catchers, Dog catching van etc. provided by RMC. All veterinary support with staff provided by the veterinary Department. After sterilization operation, operated Dogs are released at their respective place done in humane method after vaccine against rabies etc. after 6 days.

Rourkela Municipal Corporation has been providing all logistic support and monitoring the street dog sterilization in Rourkela. The scheme has entrusted to IT(RS) area w.e.f April-2015 after MOU signed by RMC with RSP. Total 1651 nos. of spay dogs have been sterilization under ABC Programme till date and released at their respective lifting point/ locality.
