Swachh Survekshan Work Shop





Implementation of Leprosy Case Detection Campaign-2016 in Rourkela city

The task force meeting on LCDC-2016 was organized in the chairmanship of Sub-Collector, Panposh in presence of various stake holders like: WCD, Education, Health, ITDA, RMC officials and Partner NGOs. The objective and modality of the campaign was vividly discussed by SDMO cum Nodal Officer, NUHM, Rourkela. A period of 14 days campaign i.e. from 14th to 27th September 2016 aiming at detecting the undetected cases of leprosy by ASHAs and Volunteers on special focus on slums, construction sites, residential schools and nomadic settlements. Throughout the campaign house hold were covered and screening were done and the positive cases were found and accordingly treatment were initiated by the service providers.


Key activities undertaken under Special Dengue Drive in Rourkela City:



Towards lessening the rising nos. of Dengue incidence in Rourkela city the National Urban Health Mission has taken several key initiatives throughout the season such as: Intensive door to door visit, search and destruction of mosquito breeding sites, creation of awareness through meeting/rallies with handholding supports of partner NGOs like: VARRSA, ORES and YAVARD. Line listing of positive cases and frequent follow up by ANMs and ASHAs to suffered families. Effective monitoring and supervision by Nodal officers allotted against the affected sub centre areas have proved to a key strategy for overcome the rising cases of dengue in Rourkela city. The convergence activities undertaken by RSP and RMC was of praise worthy and effective for taking various community level preventive measures like: fogging, Larvicidal Spray, organizing mini health camp for screening of cases by RSP in Sambalpuri Basti,Sec-18 in particular and others in general like- cleaning of drainage and disposal of garbage from slum areas by RMC.
