ADM, Rourkela cum Administrator, RMC informed all members to use the composter machine at their bulk garbage generation places.



Magana Hata at Laprocya Basti

“Saathi Haath Badhao” is a step taken up by RMC in association with Aneswha, NGO, in which each month one laprocya basti is covered. Saathi Haath Badhao is a program for a basti for a period of 3 days. In which, 1st two days, details survey is made, identified beneficiaries who are eligible for social security benefits and providing other facilities such as individual loan, IHHL, CT & PT, NFSA Card, Adhaar Card, etc. it is a single window approach system at the door step where benefits are extended to the beneficiaries.

“Saathi Haath Badhao” is followed by free market where previously collected old & new clothes are distributed among the people free of cost.

About 7985 beneficiaries have been issued with work order to construct Individual Household Latrine (IHHL) at their respective household. One NGO with their volunteers, Swachhagrahi and concerned Community Organizer are engaged for the purpose.

City Level Four Days Refresher Training for H.W(F) organised by City Programme Management Unit, NUHM, Rourkela



The City Programme Management Unit, NUHM, Rourkela conducted the refresher training of H.W(F) in two batches from 16th to 19th & 22nd to 25th April 2017 in the Meeting Hall, SDH, Panposh, Rourkela. There are a total nos of 53 Nos. of HW (F) were trained in two batches. The Resource Persons were from various domain & subject experts were invited. Among which Dr. Dillip Sahu, Rtd. (O&G), Dr. Arun Sanga, (Paed) from Hi-Tech, Health Officer, RMC, Rourkela, District level consultants like RBSK Manager, PC & PNDD, RCCVM & Dist level Trainers of Home Based New Born Care. LTs from the UPHCs for updating the diagnostic skill test among the trainees.

The major topics covered within 04 days of training includes RMNCH + A, Non-Communicable Diseases, Communication, Counseling, Diagnostics part, Reporting (RCH & HMIS), PC & PNDD Act, BMW etc. Skill based and participatory process was adopted as methodology of the training.

2 Days Field Level Training of MAS conducted by NUHM Partner NGOs

The NUHM Partner NGOs of Rourkela City like ORES, YAVARD & VARRSA have completed their assigned batches of 2 days of field level training of MAS members (President, Secretary & Treasurer) from each MAS. The key objectives of the training programme were to make them familiar with Health Plan, Leadership, Communication Skill, Negotiation Skill, Record Keeping and books of accounts. The city level Trainers imparted the training programme through adult learning and participatory process. A total No of 30 batches of training conducted through 03 nos of partner NGOs i.e VARRSA, ORES & YAVARD by which 1095 nos. of trainees were trained.
