


# RAID ON SHOPS USING BANNED PLASTIC / POLYTHENE



Collector & DM Sundargarh and Administrator, Rourkela Municipal Corporation Sri Nikhil Pavan Kalyan reviewed various developmental works carried out by RMC, RDA and Rourkela - Smart City on 26<sup>th</sup> August at the office of RMC. Commissioner, Rourkela Municipal Corporation Dr. Yeddula Vijay and other key officials from various departments were present at the meeting.



Several Unauthorized Structures constructed on footpaths and drains at various places of the city were removed/demolished by RMC in the month of August. Prior to removal of the unauthorizedly constructed structures; RMC had carried wide public awareness campaign to aware people. The Commissioner, RMC had earlier appealed all to leave the footpaths for pedestrians. People obstructing footpaths for their own purpose not only breaking the rules but creating obstacle for many, he told while addressing the public.







In a bid to stop unauthorized parking at public places; mostly in market areas, Rourkela Municipal Corporation in association with Rourkela Police carried out several enforcement drives in the city. Illegally parked vehicles on the road side were lifted by toeing vehicles. The owners of the vehicles were fined as per the law.
