On the 150th Birth Anniversary of Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi; a peace rally was conducted by the District Administration from Ambedkar chowk to Panposh chowk. Officials of Rourkela Smart City Limited and Rourkela Municipal Corporation also participated in the rally and spread the message to avoid using single use plastic items. A Fit India Plogging event was also organized by Biju Yuva Vahini wing of RMC students from several schools and college and cadets of National Cadet Corps also participated in the event. Rourkela ADM Dr. Yeddula Vijay along with other top officials joined the event and garlanded the statue of Mahatma Gandhi at Panposh Chowk.
