A two days training programme on Energy Conservation Building Code, 2017 was held for RMC, RDA & RSCL staffs at the Council Hall of Rourkela Municipal Corporation.



Biju Yuva Vahini conducted a city-wide plantation drive, "Sabuja Banani" across several wards of Rourkela.
