Rourkela Municipal Corporation got its' new leaders this Month. Collector and District Magistrate of Sundargarh district Sri Nikhil Pavan Kalyan, IAS took charge as the Administrator of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. Similarly, the civic body also got its' new Commissioner. The Additional District Magistrate and Chief Executive Officer of Rourkela Smart City Limited Dr. Yeddula Vijay took charge as the new Commissioner of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. Employees and different officials of RMC welcomed and greeted the new Commissioner on his joining. Dr. Vijay, while addressing the employees advised them to focus on addressing public grievances. He also told that to address the grievances related with basic facilities like Street Light, Drinking Water, Drain Cleaning, Sanitation on priority basis.



Rourkela Municipal Corporation have been continuously trying for empowerment of women and focusing more on strengthening their livelihood. Moving forward a step Rupees 1 lakh 20 thousand each has been distributed to 10 nos. of Women Self Help Group through ICICI Bank as part of Bank Linkage Programme for improving their livelihood under DAY-NULM scheme, at a programme organized at Rourkela Municipal Corporation office.

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (PMAY) is an initiative by Government of India in which affordable housing will be provided to the urban poor with a target of building 20 million affordable houses by 31 March 2022 throughout the country. Rourkela Municipal Corporation is also working persistently to enroll more homeless beneficiaries under this scheme. As work orders have been distributed to the beneficiaries, now its' a challenge for timely completion of the construction work. To sensitize the beneficiaries for speeding up the construction work of their homes, an awareness meeting was organized at Mundaritola, Jhartarang area. Its' a matter of happiness that, 90 percent Geotagging of the properties of beneficiaries have been completed.



To avoid traffic congestion in the Main Road and to create awareness about the traffic woes Rourkela Municipal Corporation and Rourkela Police unitedly have started action. Several Numbers of illegally parked vehicles were towed, which were illegally parked on the road and were causing traffic problem.

It's the holy month of Sawan. Devotees from all over the state including from outside the state comes to the mythologically important place Vedvyas to take the holy water and take a dip in the River. More devotees could be seen during evening hours; mostly on Sundays. Rourkela Municipal Corporation have arranged bright lights at Vedbyas Ghat for the devotees. The bright lights help the devotees to take a holy dip in the holy River.

City level task force meeting on Malaria, Dengue and Diarrhoea (MDD) & Campaign Launching ceremony of MDD 2019 was organized at the council hall of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. The ADM, Rourkela -cum- Commissioner Rourkela Municipal Corporation advised all concerned officials to focus on the MDD issues and to take necessary measures to avoid such diseases by making people aware about the reason behind it. After the meeting the concerned officials also carried out the campaign at various places to sensitize the people regarding these deadly diseases and the possible ways to stay away from these diseases.



To address the public grievances in an effective manner, the Commissioner of Rourkela Municipal Corporation have started a new initiative. Ward Committees have been formed in 33 numbers of wards. This committee will visit the wards and the people of the concerned ward can raise their issues and concerns related to basic services like Street Light, Drinking Water, Drain Cleaning, Sanitation etc. The committee of the ward will record those issues and concerns and will produce before the authorities. Then the authorities will take appropriate action to address these issues and concerns. This will minimize the time for addressing the public grievances. In this connection a sensitization meeting was also conducted under the chairmanship of the Commissioner, RMC, Dr. Yeddule Vijay, where he briefed the official members of the committee about the objective of such an initiative and appealed all to take part actively for successful implementation of the initiative.



Heaven for Homeless SUHs providing all needed support for the destitute in the City.

RMC is going to expand the capacity of the Shelter for urban Homeless (SUHs) in the city along with provision of modern facilities, which will enable the urban homeless people to live a decent life and protect them from rain, summer and cold. Except the urban homeless, special provision will be made for others like no children parents, disabled person and aged persons, who will get the benefit out of it. The SUHs are now serving as heavens for the homeless people. Special teams have been formed and activated to search such type of people and rehabilitate them in three number of SUHs operated under Rourkela Municipal Corporation. Under the administrative control of Rourkela Municipal Corporation three SUHs are running at Power House Road, Plant Site and New Bus Stand. State Urban Development Agency (SUDA) is supporting for management of these SUHs. SUDA is planning to commission Solar System, Rain Water Harvesting Structure and other facilities using natural resources in the SUHs.

It is planned to establish a new SUH near Rourkela Government Hospital (RGH) by October 2019 along with livelihood facilities for the inmates with health care and disable friendly facilities.

The SUH located at Power House Road is proposed to be a model SUH along with adherence of the parameters. Now 22 homeless rickshaw pullers along with other homeless people are staying there. RMC is providing all the facility for them like; food, drinking water, health facilities etc. To name a few; Bunduli Deep aged about 57 years of Khariabahal area is residing here who has lost her children for one year now. Similarly, a 72-year-old, physically challenged Mamata Choudhury of Jharkhand is also staying here with his son. They are being regularly provided with all needed facilities including health care. This effort of RMC is providing support to many more such homeless people.

Initially the SUHs were providing shelter to the homeless people in night. But now, it is open for homeless people throughout the day. 24-hour power supply, safe drinking water, toilet facility and CCTVs are installed for the security purpose in the SUHs. There is a proposal to construct ramp and sloppier in all the SUHs for the disabled people in near future.
