

FIRST MODEL SHELTER FOR URBAN HOMELESS OF ODISHA INAUGURATED IN ROURKELA

The first Model Shelter for Urban Homeless (SUH) of the state is inaugurated in Rourkela. Honourable Minister, Energy, Industries, Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises and Home Affairs (State Minister), Government of Odisha Sri Dibya Shankar Mishra inaugurated this model SUH in the premises of Rourkela Government Hospital. Honourable Minister expressed his happiness for this initiative of Rourkela Municipal Corporation and expected that this SUH will definitely help in sheltering the homeless and distressed persons. The 50 seated model SUH will be permanent, running though out the year; and will be open round the clock, because many homeless persons need shelter in the night, said the Commissioner of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. This model SUH is having the facilities like well-ventilated rooms, potable drinking water and adequate water arrangements for other daily needs including sanitation works, adequate bathing & toilet facilities-separate for women inmates and toilet and bathroom units specially designed and meant for differently abled persons, standard lighting facilities, adequate fire protection equipments, first aid kit, pest and vector (mosquito) control devices, regular cleaning of blankets, mattresses and sheets, common kitchen/cooking space, necessary utensils for cooking and serving, child care facilities, Personal lockers for inmates, Common recreation space, CCTV surveillance, Changing room for both male and female, Provision of sick room and a dedicated room for differently abled person with all types of equipment are available for dignified living; said Dibya Jyoti Parida, the Commissioner of Rourkela Municipal Corporation.

Rourkela MLA and Sundargarh District Planning Committee Chairman Sri Sarada Prasad Nayak also joined the inauguration programme as esteemed guest and told that this SUH will definitely fulfil the aim and objective of the concept behind it. Many people; who are coming every day to Rourkela Government Hospital accompanying patients will also get benefits of this SUH including the urban homeless people in distress. Sundargarh Collector Sri Nikhil Pawan Kalyan joined the programme as guest and told that all concerned should come forward to maintain the model SUH in a well-organized manner.

The programme was coordinated successfully by both the Deputy Commissioners of Rourkela Municipal Corporation Sri Sudhansu Kumar Bhoi and Smt. Sitadevi Majhi.



A Loan Mela under DAY-NULM has been organized in the Auditorium Hall of Rourkela Municipal Corporation. 19 numbers of sanction order under SHG Bank Linkage category and 54 numbers of sanction order under individual category has been issued to the beneficiaries by the Commissioner, RMC Sj. Dibyajyoti Parida.



The City Task Force Meeting held under the chairmanship of Commissioner, RMC for upcoming Leprosy Case Detection Campaign (LCDC) and National Deworming Day - 2020. The LCDC campaign was carried out from 14th to 29th Feb. 2020 where more than 96000 houses were covered for finding the Leprosy Suspect Cases to eliminate Leprosy from Rourkela with the help of 286 team members and 60 supervisors. Similarly The National Deworming Day was observed on 10th of this month. Deworming tablets were given to kids from 1 year to 19 years age. All the Anganwadi Centers, Schools & +2 Colleges also covered under this. Around 1 lakh 29 thousand kids were given this deworming tablet, which will help them to stay free from deadly worms and to stay fit both physically & mentally.



In the Chilling weather condition during the month #Team #RMC motivated people in distress at various location of the city and after intervention several persons took shelter at our #SUH (ଆଶ୍ରମ), located at 4 different places of the city. Also, the bonded labourers rescued from Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh also took shelter at our SUHs. We are doing continuous awareness among the people to come to our SUH to take shelter instead of taking shelter in road side and several such places. Our SUHs are totally equipped with basic amenities.



Skill Development Training Program for Safai Karmacharis (Sanitation Worker) was organized for 3 days consecutively at the City Auditorium, Udit Nagar. Where they were sensitized about various techniques to do their day to day work more effectively.



Free Health Checkup Camps were organized for Sanitation Workers of #RMC at all the Urban Primary Health Centers by NUHM, Rourkela. The workers got free health check-up, blood test, TT injection and free health counselling for different issues related to their health.

#Team Rourkela Municipal Corporation visited different slums and the Dy. Commissioner, #RMC interacted with local people about their issues. A plan to redevelop the city slums is underway and very soon the slums will be provided with more and value added facilities. Slum redevelopment is in the priority list of RMC Commissioner Sj. Dibya Jyoti Parida along with other such public welfare projects.



The Micro Composting Centers (MCCs) are under construction at various places of the city by Rourkela Municipal Corporation. Dy. Commissioner, RMC Sj. Sudhansu Bhoi reviewing the work status at construction sites. After construction of these MCCs, the solid waste management woes will be minimized to an effective extent. Commissioner, RMC Sj. Dibyajyoti Parida has given strict instructions to all concerned to complete the MCC construction work in due time period.



During mobilization, Team - RMC found a person sleeping inside the hume pipe. His name is Mr. Amritlal aged about 55 years. After telling him about the SUH and the facilities provided by Govt. for destitute persons, he came to our Plantsite SUH to take shelter.



An awareness Program on elimination of TB is organized at Orampada through folk media. The local people were sensitized about this disease through folk songs & dance. These kind of awareness programs will continue at various places of the city.



As part of yearlong national campaign for creating awareness on "Fundamental Duties" Rourkela Municipal Corporation conducted an "OPEN AIR DISCUSSION" programme with story telling session and cultural program at Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose Park Rourkela today.
